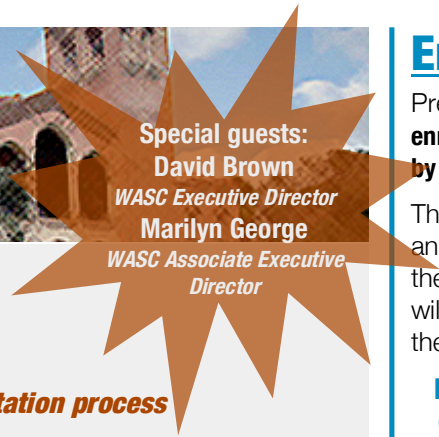

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS WORKSHOP?

The purpose of this session is to learn and practice collaborative tools to use within the ongoing WASC accreditation process.

WHAT HAPPENS DURING THIS WORKSHOP?

During this workshop, attendees will explore ways to ensure that WASC accreditation principles of school change and inquiry-based principles of student and adult learning are supported by collaborative protocols that:

- employ multiple sources of data to inform planning, decision-making, monitoring, and next steps;
- strengthen the communication and collaboration of school personnel, students, and families; and,
- deepen understanding by leadership, staff, and other school community members about how to best sustain high quality student learning.

The school principal or administrator designee, WASC coordinators, Focus and Home Group leaders, department chairs, students, parents, and all others charged with implementing your school's WASC-FOL process. Attendance as a school or district team is encouraged.
